The historic center of the city was listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1993. Submission requirements

To participate in the Second International Scientific and Technical Conference "RAILWAY ROLLING STOCK: problems, solutions, prospects" you must:

- fill out the registration form on the official website http://conference.rahimov.uz (if there are several authors, all participants should be registered);
 - send a conference (abstracts and articles) to rakhimovry@yandex.ru by e -mail.

Each article should be submitted in a separate file. The file name contains the last name of the first author, for example, "Last name.doc or .docx". Materials of participants who have registered on the conference website are accepted for publication. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to select submitted materials. The abstracts of the reports and the article undergo a mandatory check in the Anti-Plagiarism system. Only previously unpublished materials with scientific novelty, relevance, practical significance, the design of which meets the requirements, are accepted for publication. Materials that do not correspond to the topics of the conference, as well as those in violation of the deadlines for submission, volume and formatting rules may be rejected.

Requirements for the formatting of materials

Conference materials are provided to the Organizing Committee in electronic form in Russian or English, in MS Word for Windows: format - A4 (210 mm x 297 mm), font - Times New Roman, size - 14 pt., line spacing - single, paragraph indent - 1 cm, not less than 4 and not more than 8 full pages. All fields are 2.5 cm. In the upper part of the sheet, in the center, in bold type in capital letters without hyphens, the name is typed, in one line with alignment in the center in bold in lower case letters - the names and initials of the author (s), name and address (including the name of the city and country) organization (its abbreviation) in which the authors work, e-mail of all or one author. One line later - annotation text and keywords justified. Then, one line later, the main text is typed with justification in width.

The name of the report, surname and initials of the author (-s), the name and address of the organization, abstract and keywords should be in two languages (Russian, English).

Articles recommended for publications in a scientific publication are drawn up according to the requirements of the journal. General requirements for the article are presented on the website of the journal https://transportjournals.com/index.php/innotrans/general-text-requirements.
