


REQUIREMENTS FOR DRAW UP ARTICLES

Articles sent to the editorial office of the journal "Bulletin of BSUT: Science and Transport" must meet the following requirements:

1 The material of the article should reflect the profile of the journal and be stated very clearly in Belarusian or Russian. On the back of the last sheet the signature of the author(s) and the rubric to which the article refers should be.

2 The article should be presented in a single copy on paper (for non-residents – by mail) and carefully edited. At the same time, the text of the article submitted in electronic form in the "Word" editor in the form of a usual text file – by the name of the author(s), font – Times New Roman (email address: tatiana-101@list.ru).

3 The text of the article should be prepared in accordance with GOST 7.5–98 "Magazines, collections, information publications. Publishing of published materials", GOST 2.105–95 "Interstate standard. General requirements for text documents" and printed on white A4 paper by a laser printer. The volume of the article is 0.35 copyright sheets (14,000 printed characters, including spaces between words, punctuation marks, etc.), i.e. no more than 3 full pages of A4 text printed in two columns in 10 pt font according to the following pattern:



4 The text of the article should contain:

- In the upper left corner of the first page - UDC index (character height 10 pt).

- After an interval of 17.5 cm, the initials and surname of the author (s) in capital light italics, and the degree, name and location of the organizations in which the authors work, in lower case light italics 10 pt;

- Below, at an interval of 17.5 cm, the title of the article printed in capital letters, in bold, without hyphenation (letter height - 11 pt), which should reflect the main idea of the study, be as brief as possible, contain keywords that allow identify this article;

- Through an interval of 17.5 cm — an annotation in which a brief description of the article is given (letter height - 9 pt, volume - up to 10 lines, or 100-150 words);

- Through an interval of two columns with a format of 8.5 cm each, with an interval between them of 0.5 cm - the text of the article (letter height - 10 pt), line spacing - single, paragraph - 5 mm, or 3 characters.

- Through an interval of two columns with a format of 8.5 cm each - a list of references (letter height - 9 pt);

- Through the interval - the date of receipt of the manuscript in the editorial board (letter height - 8 pt); for example: Received June 5, 2009;

- at an interval of 17.5 cm — the name, initials of the author (s) - 10 pt in bold, lowercase, article title - 10 pt, lowercase in bold; abstract of the article in English in 9 pt font.

5 Scientific article should include:

- Introduction having a brief review of the literature on this issue. Unresolved issues indicated, and the goal of the work formulated and justified, that is, the statement of the problem;

- the main part containing a description of the methodology, equipment, objects of study and detailed coverage of the content of studies, which can be illustrated by graphs or confirmed by calculations in tabular form. The results obtained should be analysed in terms of their scientific novelty and compared with the corresponding known data. The main part can also be divided into subsections (with explanatory headings). Illustrations, formulas, equations, and footnotes found in the article should be numbered in accordance with the sequence of their placement in the text;

- A conclusion in which the main results obtained are stated in a concise form, indicating their novelty, advantages and application possibilities.

6 The graphic material in the article (figures, diagrams, diagrams) should contain no more than 5 figures and be designed in accordance with the requirements of R 50-77–88 "Recommendations of ESKD. Rules for executing diagrams." Each picture should have a name (font size - 9 pt light lowercase), which is placed under it (for example, Figure 1 – Motor control circuit). The inscriptions on the figures themselves are typed in 9 pt. Post-drawing after reference to it in the text. Scanned drawings are not accepted.

7 Tables (no more than 3) are located immediately after the text where they are first mentioned. Each table should have a number and a name placed above it (for example, Table 1 – Measurement results). The font size of the name and the main text of the table is 9 pt, heads (caps) - 8 pt.

8 The dimensions of all quantities used in the text must comply with the International System of Units (SI).

9 Formulas are typed with the same font size and the same headset as the main text (letters of the Russian and Greek alphabets, numbers, signs of mathematical functions - in direct font, Latin letters - in italics).

10 To the manuscript should attach:

- Information about the author [name in full, academic degree and title, place of work and position, home address, contact phone number (business, mobile, e-mail)];

- Recommendation of the department, scientific laboratory or institution in which the work was done, on the advisability of publishing an article;

- Expert opinion on the possibility of publishing an article.

11 Manuscripts that do not meet the specified requirements are not accepted for consideration.

12 The editorial board for preliminary scientific and technical examination may send an article for review to a specialist and, considering this review, gives an argued conclusion about the possibility of publishing an article.
